- Yr 3 Reading – 70% Yr 5 Reading – 70%
- Yr 3 Writing – 60% Yr 5 Writing – 65%

Embed good first teaching and classroom practice across the school through the alignment of resources including the Literacy Coach to work with class teachers to support the teaching of writing

Provide diagnostic and targeted intervention for all students with the focus on the Early Years (Prep-Year Two)

Our initiatives include

Deepen and consolidate our pedagogical practice of the teaching of writing through deconstruction and effective application of our whole school explicit teaching process.

Clearly articulate and implement the development of student goals and feedback.

Enact a strong case management process that focuses on the next steps for learning for students.

Enhance the implementation of Philosophy as the corner stone of critical and creative thinking.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Direct investment in student learning outcomes through appropriate support programs including Reading it Again and Support – A – Reader.
- Employment of a Pedagogical Coach to coach and mentor teachers in the teaching of writing.
- Alignment and development of expert teaching teams through targeted support from the STLan, Speech Pathologist and EALD Teacher
